

## Distribution of TOUCH Sponsorship Funds and Donations in 2008

Our goal is to ensure that sponsorship funds and donations are used to improve the life of the children in The TOUCH Project. All of those who coordinate the program do so as volunteers. All individuals who travel to Ukraine in efforts related to The TOUCH Project pay for all of their expenses. Below is an accounting of donations in 2008.

### Chaslivtsi Orphanage

\$24,300 from Nu Skin Force for Good Foundation to build a sports field at the Chaslivtsi Orphanage  
\$50 per child for a shopping trip for 91 children to purchase shoes and clothing  
\$50 each to 12 children who have left Chaslivtsi due to graduation or a reassignment to another facility  
\$90 transportation costs for children to and from shopping  
\$240 for Internet service for one year at two locations  
\$340 for a medical lab refrigerator and a small refrigerator for the kitchen  
\$600 for 1-2 new washing machines  
\$600 for repair of the infirmary at the orphanage  
\$665 in postage to mail birthday packages each month  
\$198 for deodorant, hand soap, laundry soap, a TV antennae, and miscellaneous supplies  
\$180 for musical program equipment  
Sponsor letter, pencil, dog tag necklace, and candy for each child  
8 quilts sewn by women in Benton County for new children

### Public School #14

\$565 for paint brushes, rollers, caulking, scrapers, ladder, sandpaper, wire brushes, "grund", etc. to paint the school  
\$3000 for brick courtyard and other improvements  
\$1800 for breakfast at the school for next 9 months (milk and bread, 5 days a week, for breakfast for ca. 30-40 children.)  
\$740 for installation of a new exterior entry door  
\$260 for school supplies, paint, and misc. needs  
8 quilts sewn by women in Benton County  
100 hygiene kits for each child and teacher

### Pavlovo Farm Home

\$800 worth of jewelry-making supplies for microbusiness project  
\$225 to supplement the jewelry project  
\$1010 for heating, electricity, petrol  
\$70 for 6 dictionaries  
\$130 for food  
Cloth bag, t-shirt, bulletin board, makeup for each young woman  
Quilts sewn by women in Benton County for 3 new girls and 1 boy

### Rehabilitation Center

\$30 each for 59 children and families  
\$30 for petrol to transport children  
\$1000 for the development of micro businesses  
\$1000 for administration expenses  
\$1000 to help with integration of the children into Public Schools  
50 pair of gloves, sponsor letters, and soft toys for each child  
3 quilts sewn by women in Benton County

### New Family Program

\$30 each for 151 children for clothes, school supplies, food  
\$840 for dancing shoes, new tires for the NF auto, food and repair of the shower at the Center  
\$120 for Internet service at the Center for one year  
\$630 for new costumes  
\$200 for dinner at Orthodox Church  
7 quilts sewn by women in Benton County for new children in the program  
School supplies, toys, arts and crafts

### Miscellaneous Expenses

\$250 Bookkeeper expenses for TOUCH Foundation in Ukraine  
\$500 for Social Work Roundtable Conference on Children with Special Needs  
\$2000 for TOUCH-related expenses of phone, Internet connection, email, and petrol for Ukrainian Coordinator in 2008  
\$800 for TOUCH-related expenses in 2009  
\$500 seed money for the 3<sup>rd</sup> Petrovo Summer Camp  
\$462 for postage and printing of TOUCH mailings, booklets, brochures  
\$43 bank and wire fees  
\$364 charged for \$25,000 worth of traveler's checks handcarried (this was unexpected and had just been enacted by the banks in Ukraine)  
\$140 for Pizza party, flowers and certificates for teen interpreters (balance paid by TOUCH Delegation)
